



IN 1798, A CONTRACT WAS MADE WITH PAUL REVERE OF BOSTON TO CAST A BELL WEIGHING 807 POUNDS AND COSTING 42 CENTS PER POUND. THE ORIGINAL RECEIPT FOR THE PRICE OF \$338.94 SIGNED BY PAUL REVERE IS HELD BY THIS CHURCH AS A PRECIOUS TREASURE. THE BELL BEARING THE INSCRIPTION "THE LIVING TO THE CHURCH I CALL, AND TO THE GRAVE I SUMMON ALL", A TRADE MARK OF REVERE BELLS, HANGS IN THE BELFRY TODAY AND IS STILL RUNG FOR CHURCH SERVICES AND SPECIAL EVENTS AND STRIKES THE HOURS.
